UZBEKISTAN VISA REQUIREMENTS

To travel to Uzbekistan you will have to get a visa unless you are a citizen of a “visa free regime” country.

A VISA-FREE REGIME

A visa-free regime is valid for citizens of 55 countries listed below. This exemption is only for short-term visits and the length of time that those citizens can stay in Uzbekistan is limited.

***Citizens with resident status of United Arab Emirates** - a visa-free regime for entering Uzbekistan up to 30 days introduced for citizens of foreign countries who have resident status of the United Arab Emirates (foreign citizens must submit the UAE original resident visa, the validity of which is at least 90 days at the time of entry to Uzbekistan).

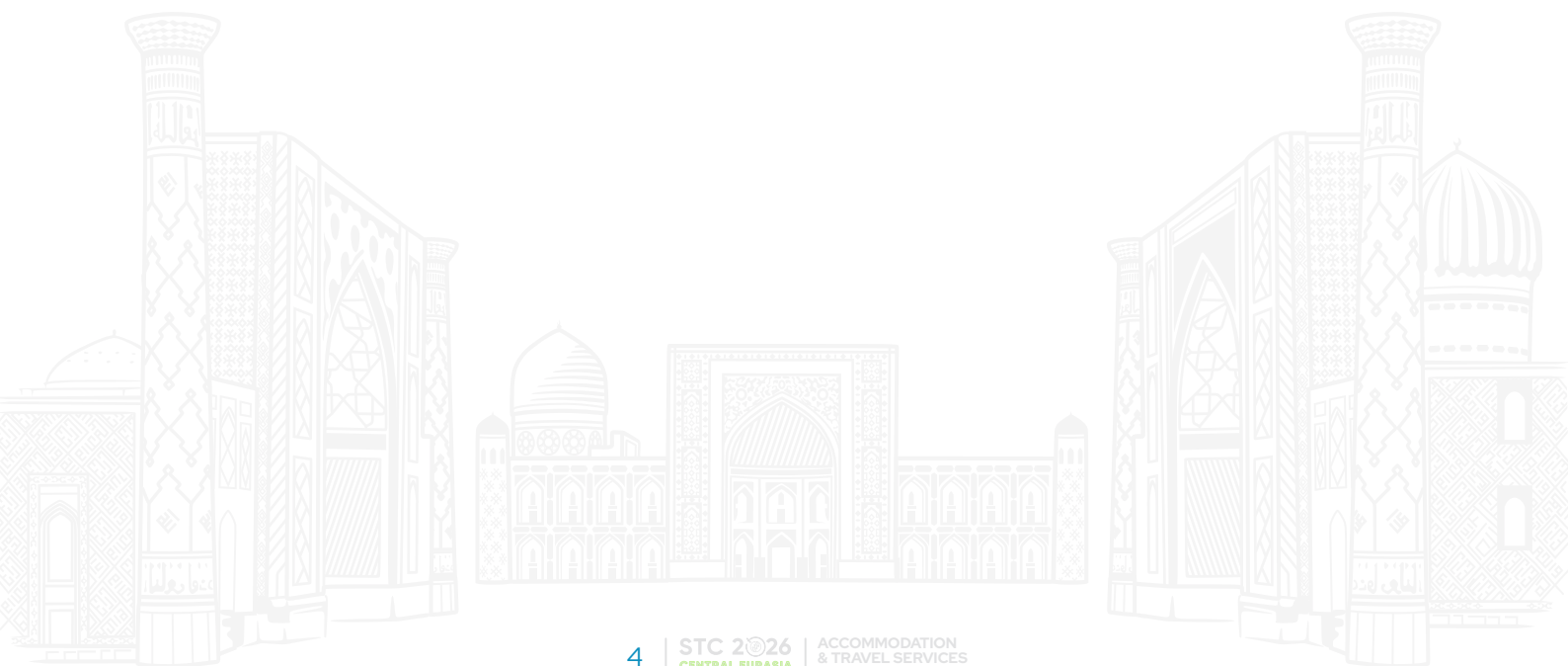

TRAVEL TIPS

AIRPORT TRANSFER

The best way to reach the city from the airport is by taxi. Official airport taxis are available directly outside the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre is typically around **\$10 USD one way**.

REGISTRATION

All foreign nationals must register their stay within **72 hours** of arrival in Uzbekistan.

If you are staying at a licensed hotel, **registration will be completed automatically** when you check in. The hotel will issue a **registration slip**, which you must carry in your passport for the entire duration of your trip, as authorities may request to see it.

Please be aware that staying in private accommodation **without obtaining registration** can lead to issues upon departure. When leaving Uzbekistan, immigration officials may ask for proof of where you stayed each night. For this reason, please keep all your hotel registration slips readily accessible.

CASH AND TRAVELLERS' CHECKS

The Intercontinental Hotel has a **currency exchange office** located in the lobby, where guests can exchange US Dollars and Euros into Uzbek Soums.

American Express Traveller's Cheques are **not recommended**, as they are not widely accepted in Uzbekistan.

CREDIT CARDS AND ATM MACHINES

Credit cards are **not widely accepted** outside of upscale restaurants and hotels in Tashkent. Most shops, restaurants, and local transport services prefer payment in **Uzbek Soums**.

ATM machines are becoming more common throughout the country, but banks generally charge a **2-4% fee** on withdrawals. The Intercontinental Hotel has an ATM onsite accepting both Visa and Mastercard.

INTERNET ACCESS

The easiest way to access the internet in Uzbekistan is via **Wi-Fi hotspots**, which are available in most hotels, cafes, restaurants, and shopping centres.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

We highly recommend that all travellers arrange **personal travel insurance** prior to their trip.

EXCURSIONS

Uzbekistan is a mysterious country of the East where the history of great cities has become legend. A country where the sun shines all year round and reflects the unique nature and beautiful hearts of people.

The country is home to some of the Silk Road's most iconic sights, including the three great Silk Road cities of Bukhara and Samarkand. Here you can see some of the world's finest Islamic architecture, painstakingly restored to its former glory, and get a real sense of what life was like when these cities were hubs of international trade.

1-day Tour to Samarkand

Explore the Old City of Bukhara, including the Poi Kalon complex, Lyabi-Hauz Ensemble, and the Ark Fortress, and immerse yourself in more than 2,000 years of living history.



2-day Tour to Bukhara

Take a more relaxed approach with an overnight stay and additional time to discover hidden madrassas, caravanserais, and the spiritual atmosphere of this ancient center of Islamic culture.
